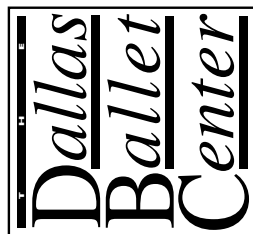

# DALLAS BALLET CENTER

Dallas Ballet Center's intensive summer workshop is designed for the intermediate to advanced dancer (ages 10-18) who has had several years of ballet study. The workshop seeks to challenge the young dancers who are seriously interested in the ballet arts, and expose them to the many other areas relating to dance.

## PLACEMENT

Students who are not currently enrolled with the Dallas Ballet Center will be placed the first day according to their technique ability. DBC students will be placed in the same level at which they are currently enrolled.

Male students will be required to wear **white shirt, black or gray tights, ballet shoes & jazz oxfords.**

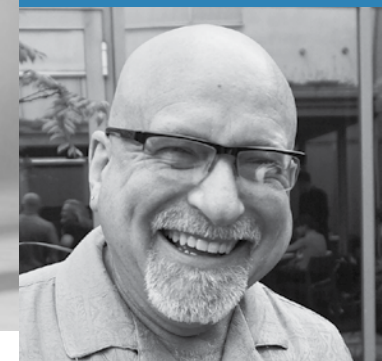
